## When God Chose Sandals:

Mark 15:21-39



1. Unfathomable \_\_\_\_\_ – Jesus, the Servant King, is willing to sacrifice Himself for His subjects (21-32)

What was part of the King's sacrifice?

- A. He accepted \_\_\_\_\_ as far as man can endure. (21-23)

- B. He endured great \_\_\_\_\_ . (24-25)

- C. He was mocked as a fool rather than worshiped as the servant Savior. (26-32)

2. \_\_\_\_\_ – The Servant King gave His life in our place as the ransom. (33-36)

3. \_\_\_\_\_ - Jesus paid the penalty for sin with His own life. (37-39)
