## **Righteousness and Justice**

*Psalm* 89:14 *Righteousness and justice are the foundation of your throne; steadfast love and faithfulness go before you.* 

#### **Definitions:**

God's Righteousness: God always \_\_\_\_\_ what is right, always \_\_\_\_\_ to His law, and is Himself the final \_\_\_\_\_ of what is right.

**God's Justice**: The expression of His righteousness as He requires all to adhere to His standards of rightness and \_\_\_\_\_\_ or \_\_\_\_\_ accordingly.

### **Exploring Righteousness and Justice:**

1. God is always \_\_\_\_\_\_ and always \_\_\_\_\_\_. (Ps 145:17, 11:7, 92:15)

Rule #1: God is always right and just.

- God's law and commands are as \_\_\_\_\_\_ as He is. (Psalm 19:8-9, 119:138)
- God's justice means He gives us what we truly \_\_\_\_\_. (Rev 16:5-7; Ecc 12:13-14)

Rule #2: If He appears wrong or unjust, \_\_\_\_\_.

- We aren't seeing the full picture. (Ps 73:11-17; Ez 18:25-29)
  - The justice of God must not be evaluated on a \_\_\_\_\_\_ basis!
  - God's sovereignty is allowing it for now for \_\_\_\_\_\_
  - The final verdict is justice.
- 2. God's justice requires that evil will be dealt with: God's \_\_\_\_\_\_ (Ps 7:11-17)

Wrath of God: His right, just, and loving eternal detestation and \_\_\_\_\_\_ of all unrighteousness.

- A. Sin is rebellion against God's authority and cannot be \_\_\_\_\_\_.

- B. God in holiness and righteousness, always \_\_\_\_\_\_ sin and reacts against it (11-13; Nahum 1:2-3; Rom 1:18, 22-24)

Does that make God mean, evil, and arbitrary?

- C. God's just wrath ultimately leads to \_\_\_\_\_ punishment of the soul for all who do not believe.
