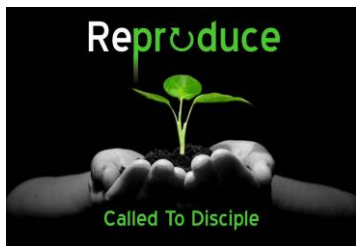


Reproduce: Called to Disciple **It's Go Time! – John 21:15-19**
