## Self-Existence

### Definition:

God is the only \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ being and has always existed with life from Himself. He is not dependent for being or essence on any source outside of Himself.

### Exploring Self-Existence:

1. God eternally existed \_\_\_\_\_ all things and time.  
Gen 1:1; John 1:1-3; Psalm 90:2
2. God's life and existence is completely within Himself and has no \_\_\_\_\_ source.  
John 5:26; Ex 3:14-15
  - When you see LORD . . .
3. God \_\_\_\_\_ all things.  
Gen 1:1; Col 1:16-17; Is 44:6

### Implications and Response:

1. We serve the \_\_\_\_\_ God – Yahweh
2. We \_\_\_\_\_ the living God – Yahweh  
Rev 4:10-11; Rom 9:20-21

## Self-Sufficiency

### Definition:

God is complete and does not \_\_\_\_\_ any person or thing outside of himself for anything. There is nothing he needs, or ever will need.

### Exploring Self-Sufficiency:

Acts 17:22-25; John 5:26

1. God has always been and will always be \_\_\_\_\_ and without need. (Is 43:7; Rev 4:11)
2. Nothing is \_\_\_\_\_ to God. (Psalm 50:12-15)  
  
Not necessary, but by His sovereign good \_\_\_\_\_.
3. Nothing can be added to God, yet we can \_\_\_\_\_ Him and bring Him joy. (John 17:5; Is 62:3-5)
4. God is \_\_\_\_\_ to no one because He does not gain from us or need us – it is all His. (Rom 11:33-36)

### Implications and Response:

1. Humble \_\_\_\_\_ to the King – God doesn't need us, but we need Him and owe Him our service.
2. The only one qualified to meet needs fully is the one who has \_\_\_\_\_ of His own
