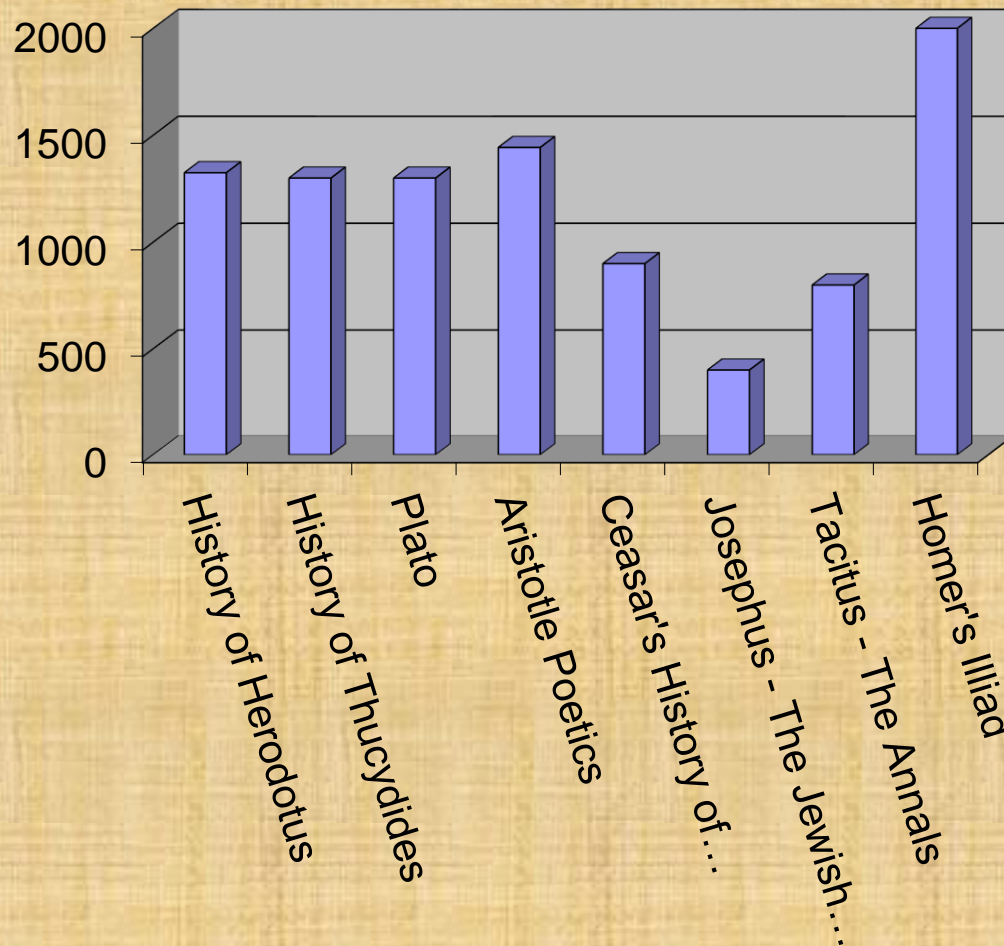

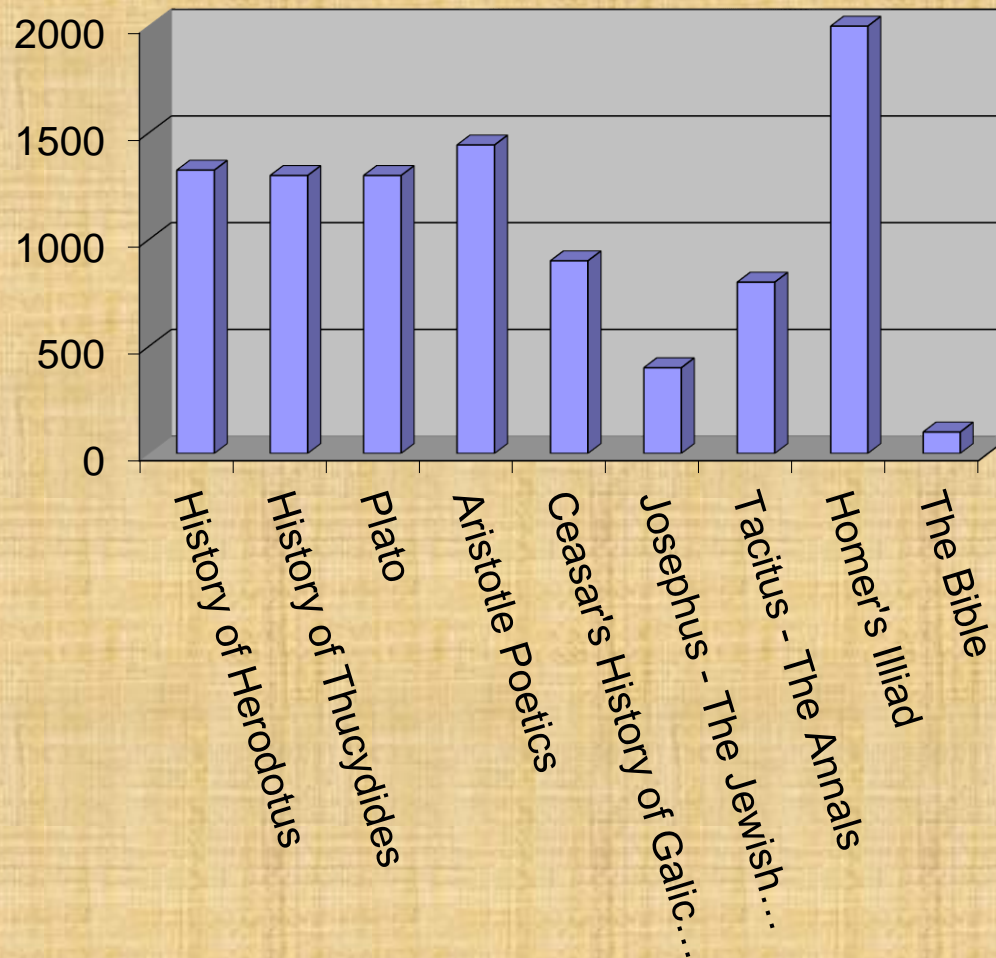

Years from original



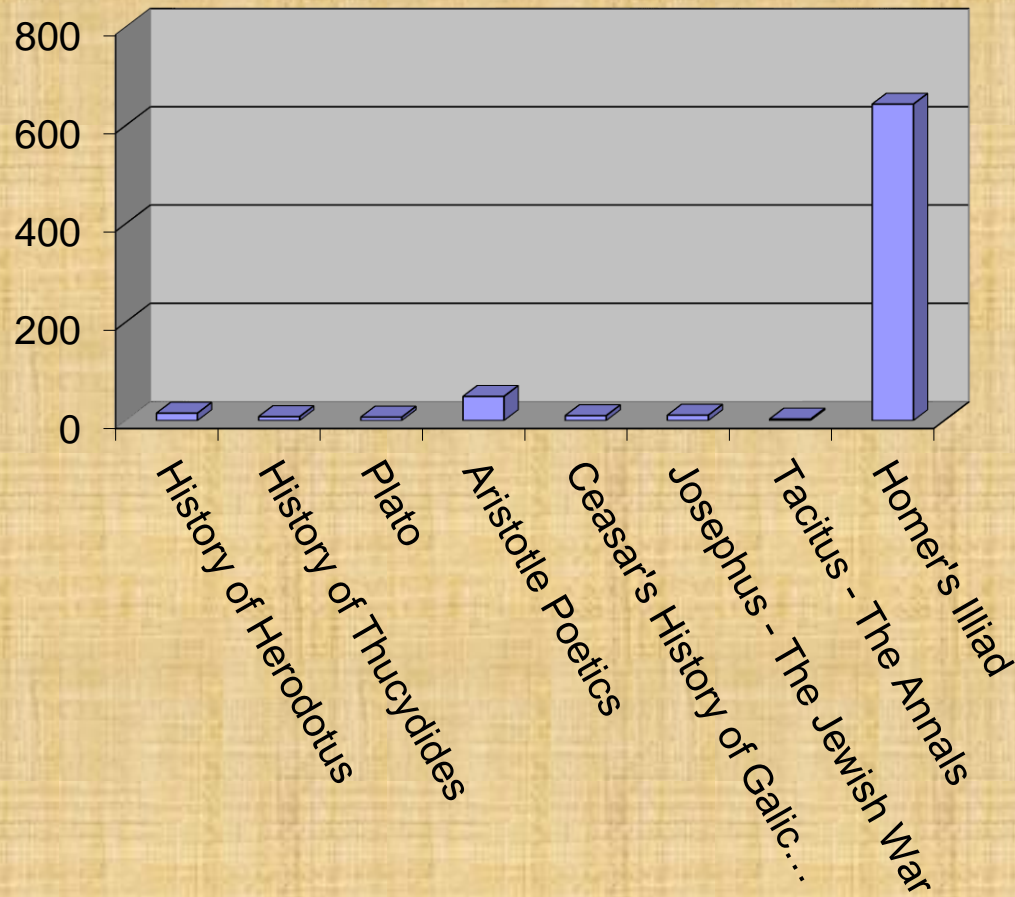
